The Oxford Core Strategy sets out the spatial planning framework for development within the City of Oxford up to 2026, and is the key document in Oxford's Local Development Framework. Oxford City Council has produced a set of proposed changes to the Regulation 30 submission Core Strategy DPD. The proposed changes add more detail but they do not make any fundamental changes to the original strategy.
