

IMD 2015 ranking highlights the *Education and Skills* domain in Oxfordshire

According to the latest Indices of Deprivation overall there are 2 areas in Oxfordshire within the 10% most deprived in England and a further 13 areas within the 20% most deprived in England.

13 out of 15 of these areas ranked as deprived on the overall IMD are also within the most deprived 10% of areas on the *Education and Skills* domain.

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NOTES

- The Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) combines information from the seven domains to produce an overall relative measure of deprivation. The domains are combined using the following weights: Income Deprivation (22.5%); Employment Deprivation (22.5%); Education, Skills and Training Deprivation (13.5%); Health Deprivation and Disability (13.5%); Crime (9.3%); Barriers to Housing and Services (9.3%); Living Environment Deprivation (9.3%). According to the guidance *The weights were derived from consideration of the academic literature on poverty and deprivation, as well as the levels of robustness of the indicators.*
- The Education Skills and Training Deprivation domain is made up of two subdomains, Children & Young People and Adult Skills, each with the following indicators:
 - Children and Young People sub-domain
 - Key Stage 2 attainment: The average points score of pupils taking reading, writing and mathematics Key Stage 2 exams
 - Key Stage 4 attainment: The average capped points score of pupils taking Key Stage 4
 - Secondary school absence: The proportion of authorised and unauthorised absences from secondary school
 - Staying on in education post 16: The proportion of young people not staying on in school or non-advanced education above age 16
 - Entry to higher education: A measure of young people aged under 21 not entering higher education
 - Adult Skills sub-domain

- Adult skills: The proportion of working-age adults with no or low qualifications, women aged 25 to 59 and men aged 25 to 64
- English language proficiency: The proportion of working-age adults who cannot speak English or cannot speak English well, women aged 25 to 59 and men aged 25 to 64
