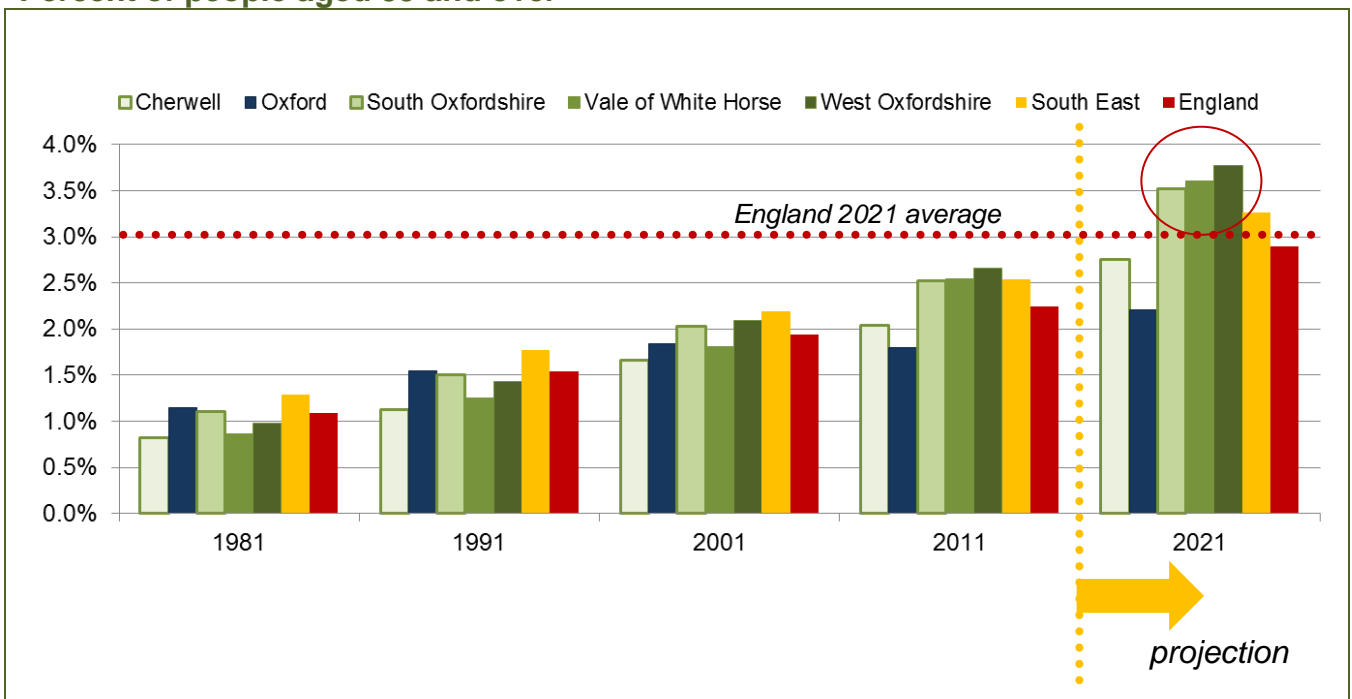


Proportion of residents in oldest age group (aged 85+) in South, Vale and West Oxfordshire predicted to be well above average by 2021

- The latest population projections from the Office for National Statistics predict a continued growth in the number of residents aged 85+ in all districts in Oxfordshire.
- The proportion of residents in this oldest age group in South Oxfordshire, Vale of White Horse and West Oxfordshire is expected to be well above the regional and national averages by 2021.
- This is a significant change compared with the position in 1981, 1991 and 2001 where all districts in Oxfordshire were below the South East average.

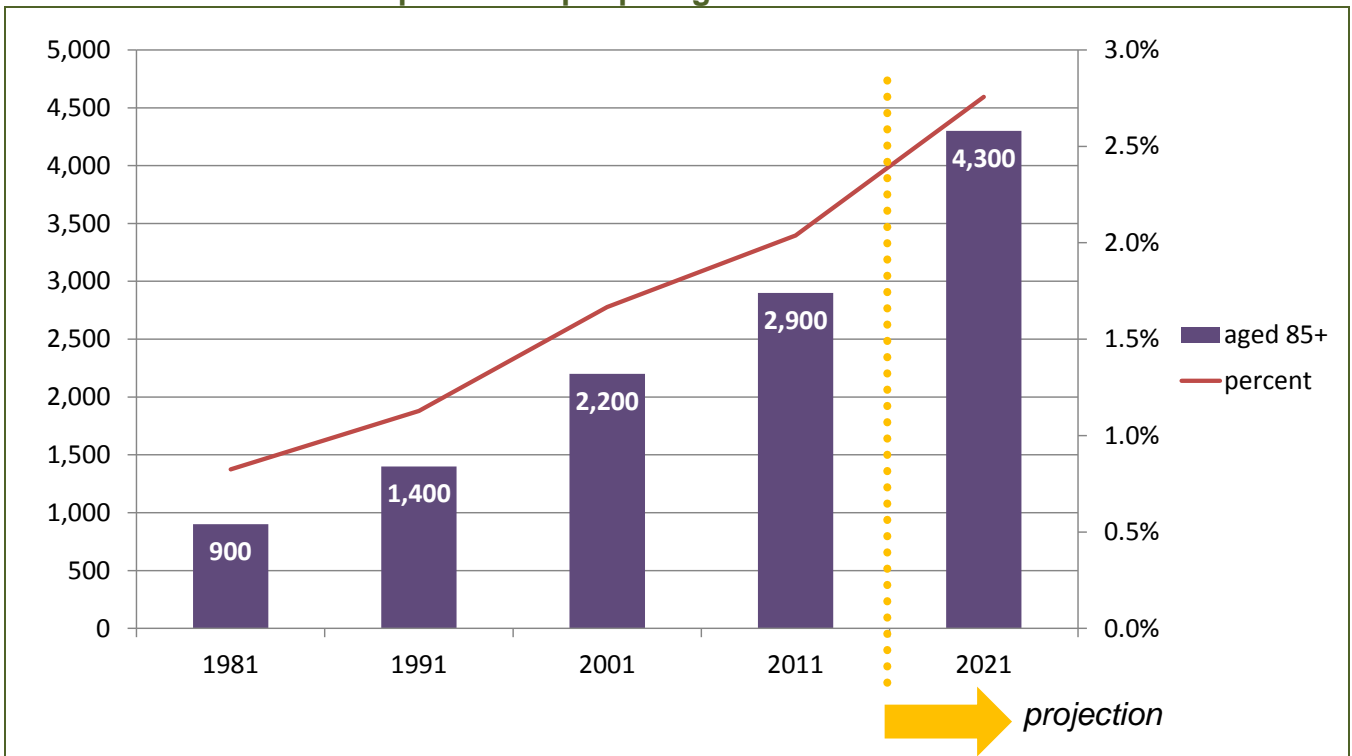
Percent of people aged 85 and over

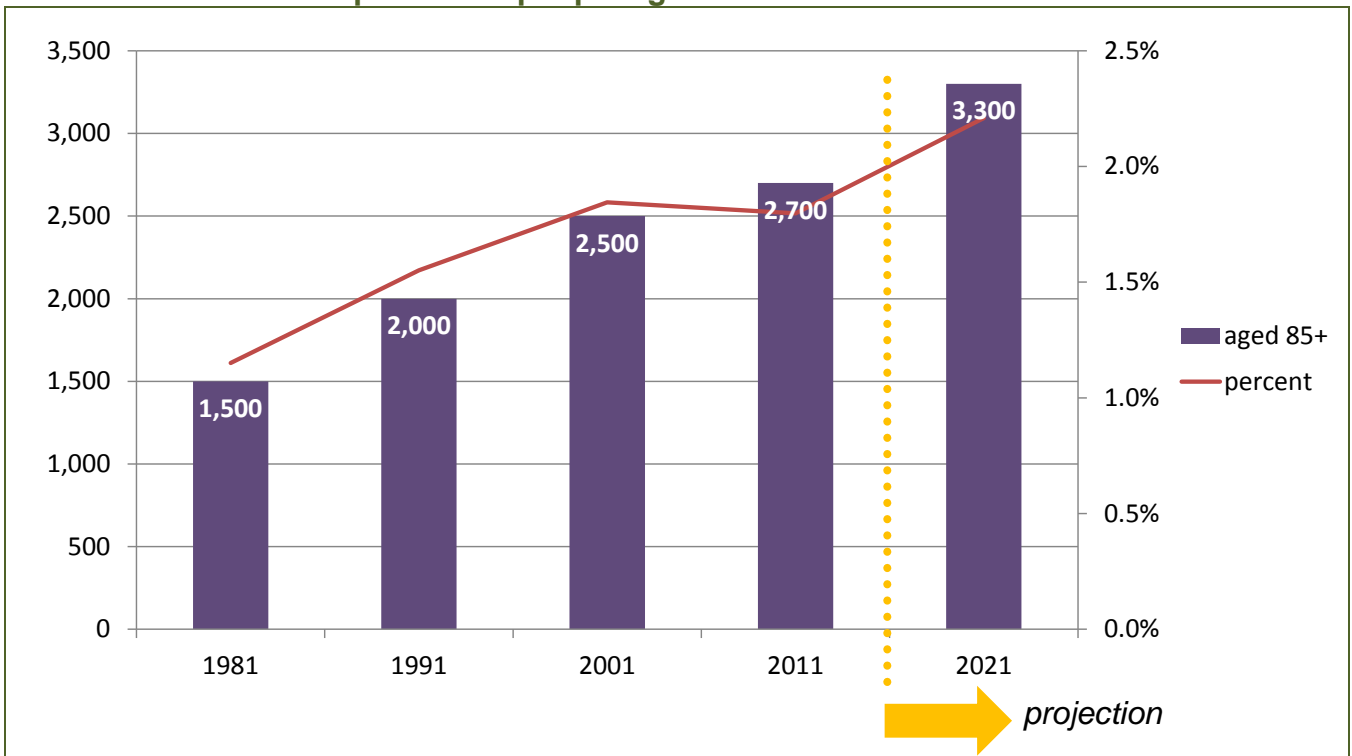

CHERWELL – count and percent of people aged 85 and over



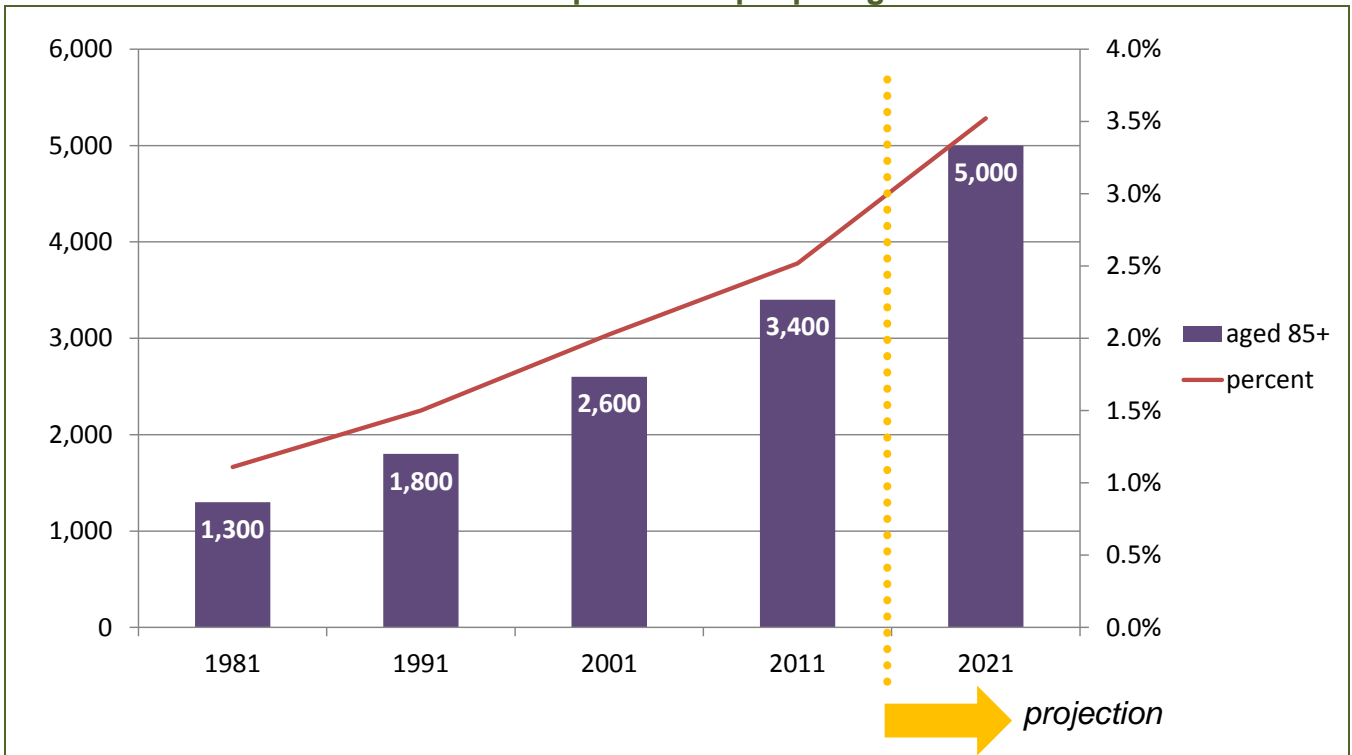

OXFORD – count and percent of people aged 85 and over



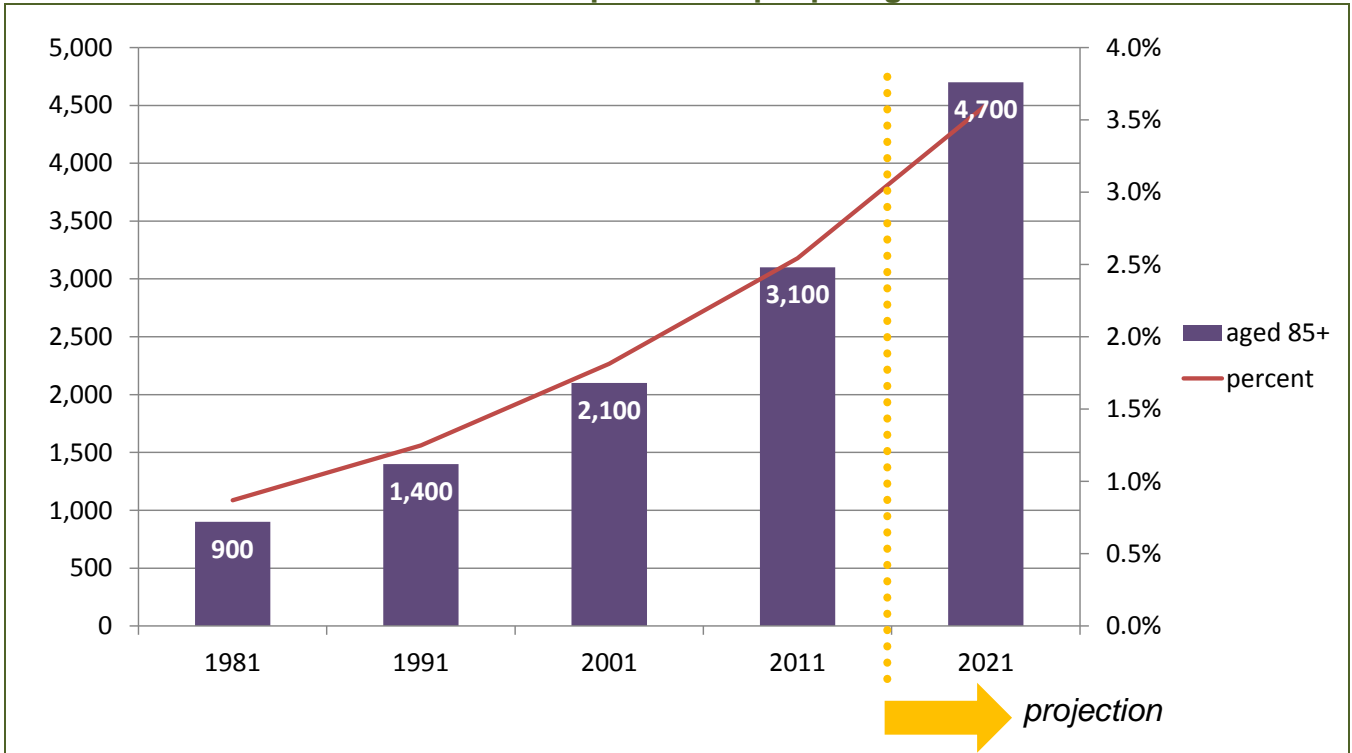

SOUTH OXFORDSHIRE – count and percent of people aged 85 and over



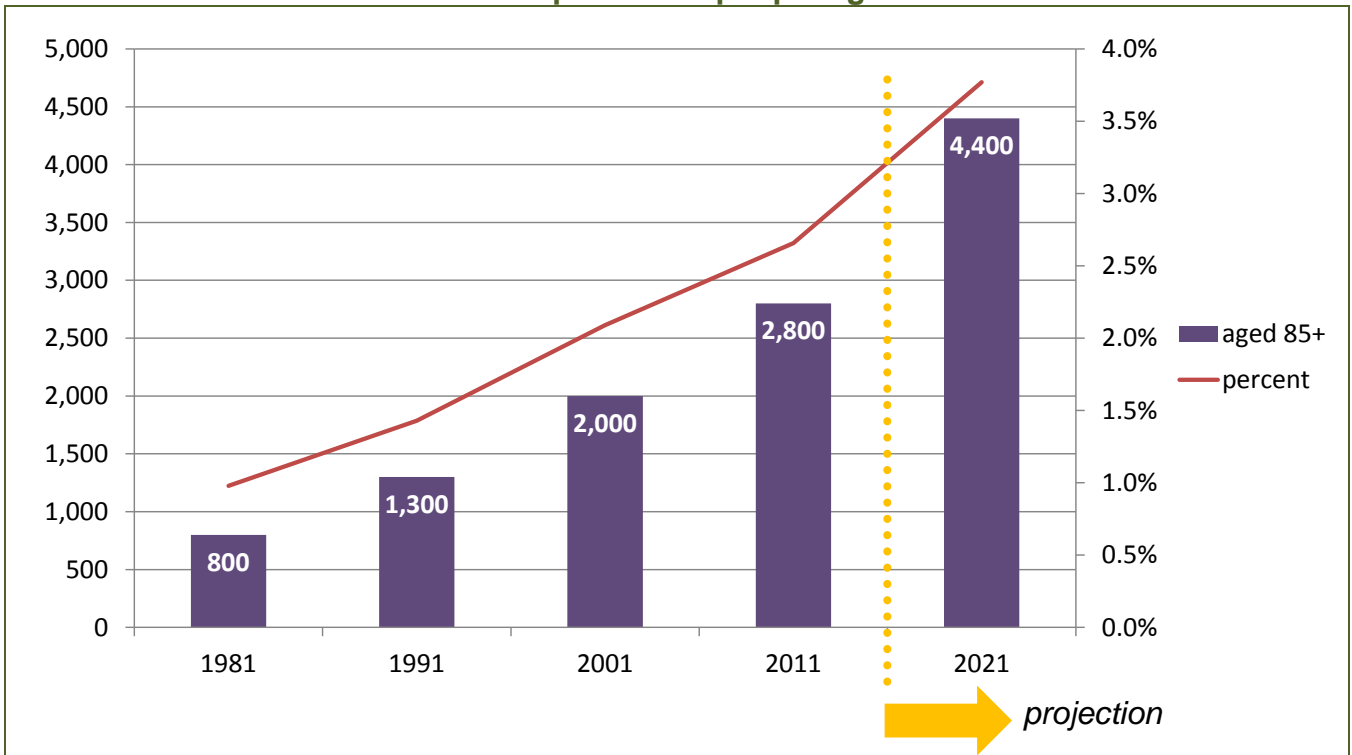
