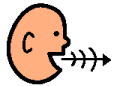

A hate crime is when someone commits a crime against you because of:



- Your race, ethnicity or nationality



- Your religion or faith



- Your gender identity (if you want to be a man or woman)



- Your sexual orientation (if you are gay or lesbian)



- Your disability



If you have suffered name calling or physical violence then you should report it.

Vandalism
