I've been following this Consultation from the perspective of being a local resident as well as a member of Norham Gardens Lawn Tennis Club. Alexandra Park and Courts are in a lovely peaceful setting, among majestic old trees and tucked away from the bustle of Woodstock and Banbury Roads.
