# **Exceptions**

- If your premises is under construction then it will not have a NDRV and it will automatically be in Band C.
- In all other cases if your premises does not have a NDRV then it is in Band A.
- If your premises form a small part of a large estate (for example a college or school), the fee will relate to the NDRV of the whole estate. If that is the case, it may be possible to get your section valued separately by the Valuation Office Agency.
  Please contact us to discuss if you think this applies to your premises.
- If Band D or E applies and your premises is used primarily or exclusively for the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, your fee is subject to a multiplier: Band D x2, Band E x3
- No fee is due if your premises is a hall attached to a church or a chapel, a village hall or community hall, and you are <u>only</u> applying for regulated entertainment (no alcohol and no late night refreshment). This is also the case for a college (for those under 19) or a school, where the proprietor makes the application.
- Where an application covers events for over 5,000 people then extra fees apply. Please contact us to discuss.

Your can check the NDRV for your premises at : <a href="www.voa.gov.uk/business\_rates/">www.voa.gov.uk/business\_rates/</a> We advise you search by inserting Oxford in the first search field (rather than the post code) and then the street and any number in the second search field. That is because we have found that postcode searches are not always reliable.
