Barton Area Action Plan (AAP) Adoption Statement December 2012

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, Oxford City Council formally adopted the Barton Area Action Plan on 17th December 2012.

The Barton AAP sets out a vision and policies to guide future development and change associated with new homes proposed at the Strategic Site at Barton.

The Barton AAP was subject to examination by an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government. The examination included hearing sessions in July and September 2012. The Inspectors' Report was received on 14th November 2012 and can be viewed at the locations set out below.

Pursuant to Section 23(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act the Barton AAP was adopted subject to main modifications and additional modifications. The main modifications are MM1 (policy MP1), MM2 (maps 1&6), MM3 (para. 4.2), MM4 (policy BA1), MM5 (policy BA2), MM6 (policy BA7), MM7 (policy BA13) and MM8 (annex 3); the full text of which can be found in the Appendix to the Inspector's Report at: <u>http://www.oxford.gov.uk/bartonaapexamination</u> and in the locations listed below. Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Barton AAP may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act. Any challenge must be on the ground that either the document is not within the appropriate power and/or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made not later than Sunday 27th January (the end of the period of 6 weeks starting with the date of adoption).
