Introduction

Welcome to the second community consultation event for the re-development of the East Oxford Community Centre (EOCC).

This is our opportunity to show you the latest draft of the plans for the Community Centre following receipt of comments from Stakeholders and the community at the last event on 20th September.

We are also sharing our preliminary ideas for the residential housing development at Princes Street and the associated developments at Collins Street and Catherine Street.

It is the intention that the existing buildings, owned by OCC will become redundant following the refurbishment and extension of EOCC and that these sites will be developed for housing. The income from which is necessary to fund the work to EOCC.

If you want to discuss any element of the design or the comments to better understand our response to these there are members of the team on hand – please feel free to discuss with them today.

Next Steps:

- The plans will be reviewed against the comments from this consultation and updated where possible.
- Further meetings will be held with stakeholders and building users for EOCC from which the plans will be finalised.
- The plans for EOCC will be fully costed and assuming the scheme remains affordable it is the intention to submit for planning permission in December.
- The plans for the new homes on the associated land at Princes Street, Catherine Street and Collins Street will be developed based upon comments from this consultation and from OCC planning department.
- A further consultation event may be appropriate depending on comments received today. This will be confirmed in due course.


