I have two points I wish to make in relation to the proposed Oxford Local Plan 2040

- 1. I am not currently one of the 276 members and supporters of the Friends of Lye Valley but I endorse most strongly their consultation response attached. I think it essential that all green spaces in the water catchment area of Lye Valley be protected from development for the reason given in the attached response. The Lye Valley reserve is a fragile and precious habitat that needs an exceptional level of care both in the valley itself and its water catchment area if it is to be preserved as the rare calcareous fen that it is today.
- 2. Oxford has an unusually high proportion of private green space. This is particularly marked in the central area but is also an issue in other parts of the city. In Chapter 4 I should like to see a stated policy of increasing public access to the city's green spaces. East Oxford/Headington/Cowley is not well endowed with green space and as an example I should like to see a policy which facilitated the transformation of the Oxford Golf Course to a public park.
