This will improve our community facility and the offer available to residents to help reduce health and skills inequalities.

In the Big Barton Chat survey 2015, we found:

- 47% of residents asked, use Barton Neighbourhood Centre (BNC), of those, 25% use it just for the Health Centre
- 52% of respondents said they don't use BNC; of those, 62% don't use it because the offer available does not interest them.

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
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
