THE CITY OF OXFORD (NO. 21) SMOKE CONTROL ORDER 1984

The Oxford City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government Act 1972 and the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The City of Oxford (No.21) Smoke Control Order 1984;"
- The area described in the Schedule hereto and for the purpose of identification only shown coloured in yellow on the map prepared and sealed with the Common Seal of the Oxford City Council and marked "Map referred to in the City of Oxford (No.21) Smoke Control Order" is hereby declared to be a Smoke Control Area.
- 3. The Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of December, 1984.

SCHEDULE

An area of 90 acres or thereabouts situated in the City of Oxford bounded by an imaginary line commencing at a point in the centre of Marston Road at its junction with the footpath to the River Cherwell thence in a westerly direction along the centre of the footpath to the River Cherwell, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of the River Cherwell to the City boundary, thence in a north-easterly direction along the City boundary to the south-western edge of the New Marston Recreation Ground, thence in a south-easterly direction along the edge of New Marston Recreation Ground, continuing in a south-easterly direction along the rear gardens of Croft Road to its junction with Marston Road, thence in a southerly direction along the middle of the Marston Road to its junction with the footpath to the River Cherwell, the point of origin.
