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CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

THE CITY OF OXFORD (NO.22) SMOKE CONTROL ORDER 1985

The Oxford City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government Act 1972 and the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The City of Oxford (No.22) Smoke Control Order 1985".
- 2. The area described in the Schedule hereto and for the purpose of identification only shown coloured yellow on the map prepared and sealed with the Common Seal of The Oxford City Council and marked "Map referred to in The City of Oxford (No.22) Smoke Control Order 1985" is hereby declared to be a Smoke Control Area.
- 3. The Order will come into operation on the 1st day of February 1986.

SCHEDULE

An area of 236 acres or thereabouts situated in the City of Oxford bounded by an imaginary line commencing at a point in the centre of Marston Road at its junction with Harberton Mead, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Harberton Mead to its junction with Pullens Lane, thence in a southerly direction along the centre of Pullens Lane to its junction with Cuckoo Lane, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Cuckoo Lane to its junction with Headley Way, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Headley Way to its junction with the road leading to the John Radcliffe Hospital, thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of the John Radcliffe access road for approximately 200 metres, then by an imaginary line across open land to the rear of Ambleside Drive and the junction of Saxon Way and Gorse Leas, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Saxon Way across the junction of Copse Lane with Westlands Drive, continuing by an imaginary line in a north-westerly direction along the centre of the footpath to the north-easterly side of Peasmore Piece to its connection with the City boundary, thence in a south-westerly direction along the Oxford City boundary to a point at the south-westerly corner of New Marston Recreation Ground, thence in a south-westerly direction along the edge of New Marston Recreation Ground and the rear gardens of Croft Road to its junction with Marston Road, thence in a southerly direction along the centre of Marston Road to the point of origin.
