CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

THE CITY OF OXFORD (NO.23) SMOKE CONTROL ORDER 1986

The Oxford City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, as amended by the Local Government Act 1972 and the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, hereby makes the following Order:-


1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Oxford (No.23) Smoke Control Order 1986".
2. The area described in the Schedule hereto and for the purpose of identification only shown coloured yellow on the map prepared and sealed with the Common Seal of The Oxford City Council and marked "Map referred to in The City of Oxford (No.23) Smoke Control Order 1988" is hereby declared to be a Smoke Control Area.
3. The Order will come into operation on the 31st day of March, 1987.

SCHEDULE


An area of 413 hectares or thereabouts situated in the City of Oxford bounded by an imaginary line commencing at a point in the centre of Headington Road at its junction with Headley Way, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Headley Way to its junction with the road leading to the John Radcliffe hospital, thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of the John Radcliffe access road for approximately 200 metres, then by an imaginary line across open land to the rear of Ambleside Drive and the junction of Saxon Way and Gorse Leas, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Saxon Way across the junction of Copse Lane with Westlands Drive, continuing by an imaginary line in a north-westerly direction along the centre of the footpath to the north-easterly side of Peasmore Piece to its connection with the Oxford City boundary, thence in a north-easterly direction along the Oxford City boundary to the point where the centre of Old Road connects with the Oxford City boundary, thence in a westerly direction along the centre of Old Road to its junction with Gipsy Lane, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Gipsy Lane to its junction with Headington Road, thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of Headington Road to the point of origin.
