The Direct Debit Guarantee

If you request Oxford City Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Oxford City Council or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
 If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Oxford City Council asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify Oxford City Council.

The Guarantee covers Direct Debit payments.
It cannot be used to address contractual disputes between you and Oxford City Council.
